



# MUIDS International Day

MUIDS will be hosting the school's first ever International Day on Wednesday May 18<sup>th</sup>. The event will take place during the school day and will help students to further develop their identities as members of an International School and as Altruistic Global Citizens. The event is designed to be a fun way to socialize with your friends while gaining knowledge and insights about a variety of cultures from around the world. The International Day 2016 Festival will include:

- An international cultural ceremony
- International Fashion Show
- Food from around the world
- Winning countries will be able to donate to an international charity of your choice



To help make International Day possible, students will be working together with the Social Science Department teachers to represent a country during our celebration. As a class, you will be responsible for introducing your country at the international cultural ceremony, creating a food item from your representative country, and creating a performance that helps to demonstrate the cultural identity of your country.

## International Day Class Assignment

This assignment will count as a project grade for your class. You will be scored both individually and as a whole class. You will also receive a certificate for 20 Hours of Extra-Curricular Activities for completing your role in the class.



**Role #1: Class leader (1 Student)**

Your role as class leader will be to oversee all groups and make sure that they are doing a good job. You will also be responsible for verifying that all students do the work they are assigned to do. You will also help decide how your stipend of 1000 baht should be distributed. We recommend most of the 1000 baht stipend is used to buy food for your food preparation.



**Role #2: International Cultural Ceremony Fashion Show (2 Student)**

Your role will be to dress up in the traditional dress of your country. You will also learn a greeting from this country and speak it during the opening ceremony, which you will then explain in English.

**Role #3: International Food Preparation (All other students)**

Your role will be to purchase the items to create your national dish, and to prepare and serve the dish during the International Food tasting. You should also plan to make a small testing sample to make sure the food you are making is delicious.
